Summary of issues raised/arising in the month.

(This document is not intended to be read as a record of the minutes of the Parish Council (PC) meeting.)

- Apologies** A gremlin slunk into last month's PC news and caused some mischief with the layout. Hopefully it didn't cause too many headaches.
- General repairs** The posts on the grass outside Neville Hall are looking quite tired and rickety so it is proposed to replace them.
The phone box on Milley Rd that the PC adopted is very overgrown with ivy so the PC will research costs for removal of the ivy. Volunteers are also welcome to come forward to do the task.
The hedge at the back of the Burial ground is in need of trimming, the PC will investigate what needs to be done and costs.
The rusted signpost on Halls Lane showing the way to the Burial Ground has been replaced.
- Shurlock Rd Nature Reserve and Play Area** Planning permission for the change of use of the Shurlock Rd Nature Reserve and Play Area site has been granted. RBWM have commissioned the two reports required by the pre commencement ecology conditions (the reports are called the Landscape & Ecological Management Plan and the Construction Environmental Plan: Biodiversity). These reports must be in place before any work can start.
The tender briefs for the play area and car park are being issued. It is hoped that both will be completed by the end of October.
